

JOHNSON, METTA FAYE DAWSON
February 13, 1892-November 16, 1924

Mrs. Metta Dawson-Johnson died suddenly at her home at Cheyenne on Sunday, cause of death having been heart failure.

Mrs. Johnson was born at Denver, Mo. on Feb. 13, 1892. She received her education at the public schools of Grant City, Mo., graduating from the high school there in 1911. She then taught school in Missouri until 1915, when she moved to Goshen county, where she taught several terms of school. She was united in marriage on Nov. 29, 1917, to Forrest Johnson and resided on her homestead until 1921, when they moved to Wheatland, living here a year. They then moved to Cheyenne where they made their home until her death. In addition to her husband, she leaves three daughters as follows: Nellie Jane, aged 5; Helen Elizabeth, aged 4; Marrioming, aged 1. She is also survived by her parents, Mr. and Mrs. G.S. Dawson and two brothers, Claude Dawson of Cheyenne and Harry Dawson of Lakeview.

She was a member of the Christian church, which she joined at Grant City, which she joined at the age of 12 years, and the Sunshine chapter of the Eastern Star No. 822 of Grant City, Mo.
