

JOHNSON, PETER BUBB
August 28, 1857-March 21, 1935

P.B. Johnson, prominent Antelope Gap farmer, passed away at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Howard Hurst, early this morning, Thursday.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the local Christian church with Rev. C.L. Morton of Guernsey in charge of the services. The body will be laid to rest in the Wheatland cemetery with the Lyla Watson Funeral Home in charge.

Mr. Johnson was about 78 years of age at the time of his death. He had been critically ill about a week.

The Johnson family came to Wheatland section about 16 years ago and settled in the Antelope Gap country where they have made their home ever since.

Besides his wife, he is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Hurst of Wheatland; Mrs. Lulu Natier and Mrs. Lottie Balance of Centralia, Ill.; one son, John W. Johnson of Wheatland. All of the children were at his bedside when the end came. A nephew, Ross Stonecipher of Illinois, was also here. Nieces and nephews of Wheatland that survive him are: Paul, Robert, Mary Ellen and Gertrude Davis and Mrs. Harry Hutchinson.
