

Rebecca Madgeline Johnson

Services for Rebecca Madgeline Johnson, 66, who died in Wheatland Dec. 19, 1987 were held at 1:30 p.m. Dec. 22, 1987 in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Dan Barcus officiating.

Born in Seymour, Mo., May 6, 1921, she was the daughter of Louis T. and Minnie (Ragsdale) Miller. At an early age she moved with her family to Odessa, Neb., and then in 1935 they moved to the Wheatland area.

On May 3, 1944 she and Arvid Johnson were married in Cheyenne. She and her husband farmed northwest of Wheatland until 1963 at which time they moved into town. Mr. Johnson died in 1984 and she remained living in Wheatland.

She was a member of the Daughters of American Revolution and the WTK Club.
