

**JOHNSON, RICHARD EDWARD**  
**September 10, 1915-January 13, 1986**

Services for Dick Edward Johnson, 70, who died in Wheatland on January 13, 1986 were held in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel, Wednesday, January 15, at 10:00 A.M. with Dan Barcus officiating.

Dick Johnson was born September 10, 1915 in Alliance, Nebraska, the son of Ira and Bessie Johnson. In 1918 he and his family moved to a ranch west of Wheatland. He spent his childhood and received his education in the Wheatland area. In 1924 the family moved to a ranch southwest of Wheatland. He and Lela Alice Murray were married in Kimball, Nebraska, on August 12, 1941. They lived and ranch in the Antelope Gap area from that time until now.

He was a charter member of the Antelope Gap Grange.

Survivors include his wife, Lela Johnson of Wheatland; one son, Jack E. Johnson of Wheatland; two brothers: Gerald W. Johnson of Thermopolis, Wyoming and Eugene Johnson of Sheridan, Wyoming; two sisters: Mary Cox and Lucille Knudson, both of Wheatland; and two granddaughters.

He was pre-deceased by his parents and an infant granddaughter.
