

JOHNSON, TENSIA SVENSON
November 6, 1886-August 3, 1964

Last rites for Mrs. Tensia Johnson were conducted by Rev. Elmer A. Reuscher at the Trinity Lutheran Church on Aug. 6, at 11:00 a.m. with interment in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mrs. Johnson was born Nov. 6, 1886 to Bengt and Maria Peterson Svenson in Sweden. She came to the United States in 1906, and was united in marriage to Lambert Johnson October 5, 1907 in Omaha, Nebr. They were engaged in ranching near Dix, Nebr. when their six children were born. In 1920, they moved with their family to Wheatland and resided on their farm west of Wheatland until the death of Mr. Johnson in 1947.

The deceased was an active member of the Trinity Lutheran church until illness confined her to her home. Death occurred in the Platte County Memorial Hospital on August 3, 1964 after an extended illness.

Survivors include a son, Herman Johnson of Wheatland; four daughters, Mrs. Elsie Jessen, Mrs. Edla Geringer, and Mrs. Lenora Patterson, all of Wheatland and Mrs. Evelyn Stephens of Pine Bluffs; 20 grandchildren and eight great grandchildren. A sister, Mrs. Anna Bengtson and several nieces and nephews in Sweden also survive.
