

JONES, AMANDA WILLIAM LAMBERT

July 30, 1860-September 15, 1941

Mrs. C.H. Jones, 30 year resident of this vicinity, passed away Monday. Services were held here Wednesday, Sept. 17, with Rev. J.L. Williams and Rev. Alva Jones of Brighton, Colo., officiating and the Copley Funeral Home in charge of arrangements. Interment was at the Wheatland cemetery.

Amanda William Lambert was born July 30th, 1860 in Trigg county, Ky. She was united in marriage to C.H. Jones on Jan. 7, 1879. In the year 1880, they moved from Kentucky to Kansas and came to Platte county in 1910. Here they have resided since that time.

To this union were born three children, Clarence Amos who died in infancy, and Edgar who lives in Wheatland and Mrs. Ethel Guthrie, also of Wheatland.

Mrs. Jones was a strong character, a pioneer, a true friend, a good neighbor, and loving wife and mother.
