

JORDAN, HAZEL R. RUMSEY

April 23, 1897-March 13, 1977

Hazel R. Rumsey Jordan, 79, passed away Sunday, March 13, at the Goshen County Memorial Hospital in Torrington, Wyoming. Services were held Wednesday, March 16 in Lusk and burial was at the Wheatland Cemetery.

She was born April 23, 1897 in Fullerton, Nebr. to Edward and Lillian Sample Rumsey. She moved to Wheatland as a young child and graduated from Wheatland High School. She married Myriel S. Jordan in Wheatland June 1, 1919. In 1938, she and her husband moved to Lusk, Wyo. where they made their home until he passed away in 1962. At that time, Mrs. Jordan moved to Wheatland and lived here until the fall of 1966 when ill health forced her to move to Torrington to make her home with her daughter, Maxine Paisley.

She is survived by four daughters, Martha McQueen of Page, Arizona; Maxine Paisley of Torrington, Wyo.; Evelyn Wade of Jackson, Miss.; Ellen Bonner of Laramie, Wyo.
