

JUDD, LILLIAN ABBEY WEST
1863-October 25, 1941

Mrs. Lillian Abbey Judd, a resident of this community for 24 years, died at the Wheatland hospital Saturday, October 25. She had been in ill health for some time, but was not confined to the hospital until Friday.

She was born in Philadelphia, Penn. in 1863 and was united in marriage to Joe Judd in 1888. Her husband preceded her in death. There were three children born to this union.

Services were held at the Episcopal church Tuesday afternoon. Rev. W.I. Lockwood officiated and the Eastern Star services were held at the Wheatland cemetery, the place of interment. Pallbearers were A.B. Bartlett, E.A. Rappuhn, Rev. Waddell, Sam Isabell, Elmer Doane, and Emerson Kraeger.

Survivors are two sons, Norman of Wheatland and Kenneth of Casper, and a daughter, Marjorie of Denver. Also a nephew, Jarvis of Wheatland, and a niece, Maxine of Denver.
