October 13, 1922-January 9, 1960

Last rites were conducted from the Schrader Funeral Chapel for Elbert A. Judson of Wheatland, Wednesday, January 13, 1960. Mr. Judson passed away in Bend, Ore. January 9, following an extended illness.

Mr. Judson was the son of E. C. and Bertha Richards Judson and was born in Orpha, Wyo., October 13, 1922. He made Wheatland his home for 18 years, coming here from Torrington. He was a veteran of World War II and a member of the Reorganized Latter Day Saints Church.

Elder Ken Fisher officiated at the 2:00 p.m. services and interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
