Funeral services for June Eileen (Large) Juschka, 90, was held at 2 p.m. on Saturday, May 24 at the First Christian Church in Wheatland with Pastor Andy Gudahl officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery. June Juschka joined the angels on Sunday, May 18 at the Davis Hospice Center in Cheyenne surrounded by her loving family.

She was born Nov. 14, 1923 in Fort Washakie. June was the only child of Roy Shade and Margaret Mary (Merna) Large. June was reared and educated in Fort Washakie and south of Cheyenne on the family ranch. She attended Haskell Indian School in Lawrence, Kansas. She married Robert Joseph Carlow in 1943, and Carlow was killed in action in Germany in the Battle of the Bulge during World War II in 1945.

In 1948, June married R. Elmer Juschka of Wheatland. June spent her life working on the farm with her husband and watching her children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren grow. After Elmer's death in 1996, June moved back to the family ranch south of Cheyenne.

June was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Elmer, on Feb. 1, 1996; and her daughter, Marlene Moxley.
