

KAMPSI, CHARLES K.
April 28, 1885-January 12, 1967

Last rites for Charles K. Kamps, a retired coal miner, were held at the Schrader Chapel, Jan. 14, 1967 at 11:00 a.m. with Rev. Henry Hartberg officiating. Interment was in the local cemetery. Casketbearers included Auldon Vogt, Joseph P. Johnson, Robert Straw, Sam Christensen, Sam Edmiston and Earl Locke.

Mr. Kamps was born in Finland April 28, 1885. He resided in Cumberland, Wyo. from 1901 until 1930 when he moved to Superior. He was married to Hilja Kettula in Cumberland, Oct. 31, 1906. She preceded her husband in death on Nov. 22, 1961.

Death occurred in the Platte County Memorial Hospital Jan. 12, 1967 where he had been a patient for 12 days. He was a member of the Finnish Lutheran Church.

Survivors are two daughters, Mrs. Lawrence Bays of Wheatland and Mrs. Lila K. Young of Lander. One son, Jacob Norman Kamps, preceded him in death in 1907. One granddaughter, Mrs. Sal Planeta, Hamden, Conn., and two great grandchildren also survive.
