

# Charles T. Keating

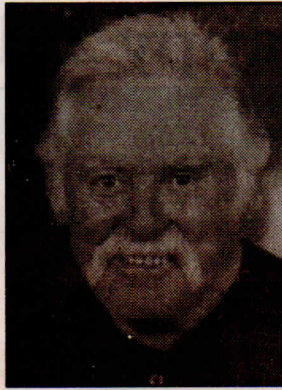
June 20, 1934 - January 1, 2017

Charles Keating passed away Sunday, Jan. 1, at the Cheyenne Regional Medical Center in Cheyenne.
