

KEELE, JOHN THOMAS  
June 7, 1866-April 12, 1937

John Thomas Keele, aged 71 years, passed away in Wheatland on Monday, April 12, after a short illness. He is survived by two sons, Rev. Romie Marshall, of Lakeland, Fla. and C.B. Marshall of Lewisburg, Ky. and three brothers, W.J. Keele of Innis, Texas, W.H. Keele of Louisville, Ky. and Charles Keele of Van Lear, Tenn.

Mr. Keele was born at Big Springs, Tenn. On June 7, 1866. He has been a resident of Wheatland since 1925 and had many friends here. For a number of years, he had made his home with Bob Scott.

Funeral services will be conducted from the chapel of the Watson & Dennis Home for Funerals on Friday afternoon at two o'clock. Rev. J.L. Williams will have charge of the services and interment will be made in the Wheatland cemetery. None of the relatives will be able to attend the last rites for Mr. Keele.
