

KELSEY, HATTIE MEMMER
October 10, 1890-March 7, 1958

Last rites were held Thursday at 2:00 p.m. from the Schrader Chapel for Hattie Haworth, 67, who passed away March 7, 1958. Death was the result of an automobile accident.

Hattie Haworth was born in Lost Nation, Iowa, October 10, 1890. She lived in Wheatland from 1905 until 1912. For the past year, she has been making her home in Fontana, Calif., and for several years lived in Casper as well as in Idaho. She was a member of the Methodist Church.

Surviving are two sons, Edward C. Kelsey, Fontana, Calif., and Lyle S. Kelsey, Green River; three brothers, Blaine Memmer and Francel Memmer of Wheatland,; and two sisters, Ethel Van Osdol, Rangely, Colo., and Mrs. Iva Rhodes, Malcom, Iowa. Five grandchildren also survive.
