

KENNEDY, DOROTHY MARGUERITE QUIRK

June 18, 1905-January 16, 1978

Services for Dorothy Marguerite Kennedy, 72, of Rock River, will be held Thursday, January 19, in the United Methodist Church of Wheatland with Rev. Frank Moore officiating. Burial will be in the Wheatland Cemetery. Mrs. Kennedy passed away at her home Monday, January 16, 1978.

She was born in El Paso County, Colo. June 18, 1905 and graduated from high school in Colorado. Following high school, she attended college at Ft. Collins and upon graduation, taught school for one year at the Harry Garlock School and one year at Split Rock.

In 1928 she homesteaded on a ranch in Wyoming. On June 4, 1929, in Denver, Colo., she married William H. Kennedy and they lived on the ranch in Wyoming until her death.

Mrs. Kennedy was a member of the Wyoming Federation of Women's Clubs, a charter member of the Laramie Dell Women's Club, past Worthy Matron of the Order of the Eastern Star, and a member of the Daughters of the Nile. She served on the Albany County Fair Board and was clerk for School District No. 23 School Board for many years.

Survivors include her husband William; two sons, Jerry and Gene Kennedy of Rock River; two brothers, Ed Quirk of California and Paul Quirk of Denver, Colo.; two sisters, Mrs. Carl Dismoant and Mrs. Al Watkins of Denver and five grandsons. One brother, Chris Quirk, preceded her in death.

Pallbearers will be Tyler Dodge, Bill Dannar, David Dodge, Jack Nixson, Roy Martin and Owen McGill. Honorary pallbearers are George Dodge, Stuart Berry and Emil Collins.
