

9-23 HAROLD G. KENNEDY 1986  
Services for Harold G. (Pete) Kennedy, 73, who died in Casper, September 23 were held Saturday, September 27 at 10:30 a.m. in the First Christian Church in Wheatland with Chet Shaw, minister.

Born November 26, 1912, in Tekama, Neb., Pete was the son of Martin and Ida (Stevens) Kennedy. He attended school in Tekama and upon his father's death, moved with his mother to his brother's homestead in Albany County. He completed his education in Laramie. He then filed his own homestead which he operated in connection with two brothers, Bill and Jack Kennedy.

In 1950 he married Winnie Chappell in Laramie. The couple lived on the ranch and she taught at the Kennedy School there. In 1958 she began teaching in Wheatland. He retired from the ranch in 1981.

He is survived by his wife, Winnie Kennedy of Wheatland.

He was preceded in death by four brothers: Ralph, Edward, Jack, and Bill, and by two sisters: Cora Toliver and Margaret Kennedy.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
