

KERSEY, ANDREW JACKSON

October 26, 1866-June 16, 1933

Andrew Jackson Kersey passed away in his home Friday evening after an illness of several days as a result of tick fever, contracted while he was employed in the mountains west of town.

Mr. Kersey was born in Lafayette, Indiana, October 26th, 1866. He later moved to Illinois where he was married to Miss Edna Frederick at Waukakee. She, with five sons, Howard, Lloyd, Leslie and Russell of Wheatland and LaVerne of Laramie, three grandchildren and other relatives survive him.

Funeral services were conducted for him in the Christian church, Monday afternoon at 2:30. Rev. Cecil V. Smith in charge. Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery under direction of the Lyla Watson Funeral Home.
