

KERSHNER, LE ROY C.
August 5, 1891-June 16, 1951

Le Roy C. Kershner 59, who for the past 36 years operated a ranch and farm 19 miles east of Wheatland, died suddenly at his home on Saturday, June 16, death resulting from a heart attack.

Last rites were conducted at 10 a.m. Tuesday in the Congregational church, the Rev. W. James Hoare officiating, and arrangements by Schraders. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery and pallbearers were Joe Weber, Roy Anderson, Lee Blevins, Lee Marr, Earl Romig and Oscar Throckmorton.
