

KESTIE, ELI SAMUEL  
January 17, 1910-March 9, 1970

Funeral services for Eli Samuel Kestie, 60, were held Thursday, March 12, at 2:00 p.m. at the Nazarene church. Rev. W.E. Tyler officiated and interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.
