

Cycle wreck fatal

A Wharfedale woman was killed Sunday when she lost control of the motorcycle she was riding and fell in a mobile home.

According to Wharfedale police chief Dick Evans, Marie Len Kestie, 29, 605 Oak Street, died Sunday about a half hour after she wrecked her 250 cc motorcycle.

Evans say that at noon Kestie was apparently driving her cycle at a "high rate of speed", around 45 mph, through the Oak Park Trailer

court when she lost control, fell, striking 100 feet, and hit a mobile home.

He says that immediately after the wreck Kestie was taken to Fatta (Fata) Memorial Hospital, but that she died there around 12:30 p.m.

County Coroner Harley J. Yell said that no inquest is scheduled.
