

KINCAID-AMANDA-M-TIPTON

1854-December ?, 1920

Amanda Tipton Kincaid was born at Northfield, Ind. In 1854. On October 18th, 1872, she was married to Samuel A. Kincaid of Lebanon, Ind. Three children were born to this union, two of them dying in infancy, the third being drowned at the age of eighteen. In 1881, with her husband, she went to South Dak. After a short residence there, they went to Missouri and later to Kansas where they lived a number of years. About two years ago, Mrs. Kincaid in poor health, came to Wyoming, with her husband, locating on a farm two miles west of town. During the last year, she failed rapidly in health, death relieving her on Friday of the past week.

She leaves, besides her husband, four brothers and one sister, William of Veedereburg, Ind.; Francis of Trinidad, Colo.; J.W. of South Dakota, T.H. of Rich Hill, Mo., and Mrs. Sarah Lindaey of New York State. The funeral was conducted from the Pepper Mortuary on Sunday afternoon by Rev. Chas. M. Walen of the Christian Church. At the time of her death, the deceased held membership with the Christian church in North Haven, Kan.
