

KINNAMON, ALICE LOUISE
September 28, 1940-March 30, 2009

A memorial service for Alice Louise Kinnamon, 68, will be conducted at 10:00 A.M. Monday, April 6, 2009, at the First Christian Church in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Pastor Andy Gudahl officiating. Inurnment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

She died Monday, March 30, 2009, at the Hospice Center in Casper, Wyoming.
