

## Samuel Kelsey Kinnamon

Funeral Services for Samuel Kelsey Kinnamon, 78, were held Wednesday, March 3, 1993, at 10:00 a.m. at the First Christian Church in Wheatland, with Andy Gudahl, Minister, officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
