

Three young men lost their lives Monday evening, December 1, 1975, in a one car accident two miles west of Guernsey. They were Forrest "Frosty" Kinsolving, 22, son of Mrs. June Short of Wheatland and Kenneth Kinsolving of Cheyenne; Cecil Craig Miller, 20, son of Mr. and Mrs. Cecil Miller of Wheatland; and David R. Wright, 25, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ralph W. Wright of Pittsburg, Kansas.

A fourth passenger in the car, Bill Borthwick, 23, son of Mrs. LaVerne Borthwick is listed in satisfactory condition at the Platte County Memorial Hospital.

The accident occurred about 7:30 Monday evening when the car the four were riding in went off the road at a curve hitting an embankment. The car traveled through the air approximately 90 feet, hit again, and went end over end.

Deputy Coroners Bud Torrey and Fred Berry and Highway Patrolman Chuck Lowry were at the scene of the accident. According to them, Kinsolving and Wright were thrown from the car and were found dead at the scene. Craig Miller died on his way to the hospital.

An inquest is pending according to Deputy Coroner Torrey.
