

**Mrs. Mary Kipfinger
Pioneer, Is Buried
Sunday Afternoon**

Mrs. Mary Kipfinger, one of the early Wheatland Flats pioneers, passed away at the home of Mrs. Nelile Holcomb, Thursday evening, February 11. Mrs. Kipfinger had been ill for a long time and while her friends had little hope for her complete recovery her death came as a distinct shock.

The deceased was born November 9, 1858 in Sweden. Mr. and Mrs. Kipfinger moved to a farm, about a mile west of the Ferguson corner, when that country was being settled and lived there for a number of years. Her husband preceded her in death several years.

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon from the Congregational church. Rev. R. E. Morgan preached the funeral sermon and interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Longwith-Richards Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
