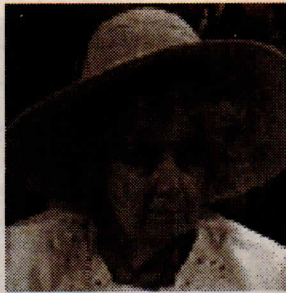
Cora Kirk died Monday, Sept. 12, at her home in Wheatland, Wyoming.
