

KISSELL, WILLIAM HENRY  
August 6, 1901-October 23, 1964

William Henry Kissell, age 63, succumbed in the DePaul Hospital in Cheyenne on Oct. 23, 1964, after an illness of two weeks. A Guernsey resident for 25 years, he had been employed as a main line inspector for the Kansas-Nebraska Gas Co. for the past 17 years.

The deceased was born in Coal Creek, Colo. on August 6, 1901 to John Henry and Mary Ann Rochchester Kissell. He served in the U.S. Navy from 1920 to 1921.

Services were conducted by Rev. Ralph Martin at the Schrader Chapel in Wheatland at 2:00 p.m., October 26, with interment in the Wheatland cemetery. Fellow workers of the Gas Company served as pallbearers.
