

KITTELL, HARRY FRANKLIN  
September 15, 1899-June 15, 1980

Harry Franklin Kittell, 80, died Sunday, June 15, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital.

Kittell, the son of George and Annie Swope Kittell, was born in Nemaha County, Neb., Sept. 15, 1899.

He married Ione M. Paullin in Kimball, Neb., Aug. 11, 1923.

He was raised in Nebraska and as a young boy, he moved to Oklahoma. He then moved back to Nebraska and in 1919, he moved to Arocola, Wy., 20 miles east of Cheyenne.

He and his wife operated a dairy farm until 1946 when they moved to Saratoga.

They operated the Medicine Bow Lodge Dude Ranch for a short time there.

In 1948, they moved to Wheatland, and have ranched here until ill health forced his retirement.

He was a member of the Odd Fellows Lodge, Laramie Peak Stockgrowers Association, National Stockgrowers Association. He was an avid outdoorsman.

He is survived by his wife, Ione, of Wheatland; one son, Earnie Kittell of Wheatland; one daughter, Betty Stockwell of Saratoga; one sister, Eva Kent of Cheyenne; six grandchildren, and one great grandchild.

Funeral services will be held Thursday, June 19, 1980, at 2 p.m. at the First Christian Church. Daniel Barcus will officiate. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.
