

KLIER, FREDRICK, SR.

September 21, 1903-November 16, 1975

Monsignor Corrigan will conduct funeral services for Fred Klier, Sr. Wednesday, November 19, 1975 at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel at 2:00 p.m. Interment will be at the Wheatland Cemetery. Members of the Wheatland VFW will serve as pallbearers.

Mr. Klier died Sunday, November 16, 1975 at the age of 72 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital after a brief illness. He had been a resident here for 54 years.

He was born September 21, 1903 in Laurence, Massachusetts. He came to this area as a young man working for the Swan Land and Cattle Company. He married Avis Wilson October 12, 1925 in Wheatland.

Klier served 14 months in the South Pacific as a member of the U.S. Navy during World War II and was awarded the Bronze Star. At the time of his death, he was a retired electrician having been self-employed in his own business, Klier Electric, for years.

He was a member of the VFW, Post Commander of District #5 VFW, and also served as Service Officer for District #5.

In death he is survived by his wife Avis of Wheatland; one son, Fred Klier, Jr. of Cheyenne; one daughter, Mirriam Breisford of Alamosa, Colorado; and thirteen grandchildren and one great grandchild.
