

**YOUTH SUCCUMBS TO HEART
FAILURE FOLLOWING BOX-
ING BOUT** 8-12-30

On Saturday night at the Anderson-
Srader carnival in Wheatland, two of
the local boys, Victor Kling and Geo-
rge Pauli, engaged in a boxing con-
test, in which Victor Kling, age seven-
teen, overexerted himself, causing ac-
ute dilation of the heart from which
he died at the ringside.

Victor was the son of Mr. and Mrs.
Fred Kling, who recently moved here
from Fort Lupton, Colorado. George
Pauli is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Philip
Pauli, who came here quite recently,
buying the old Bovee farm some six
miles west of town. Mr. and Mrs. Kl-
ing had a son killed by a train a few
years ago. The American Legion was
sponsoring this bout and they are
paying all funeral expenses. The fun-
eral was held from the Methodist
church on Tuesday afternoon, and
burial was made in the Wheatland
cemetery with arrangements in charge
of the Watson Mortuary. It has been
a very hard blow to the two families
though no blame attaches to George
Pauli in the matter.
