

## **Albert P. Krewer**

*October 5, 1909-May 8, 2000*

Services for Albert P. Krewer, 90, were held Thursday, May 11, 2000, at 10:30 a.m. at First Christian Church in Wheatland, Wyo., with Andy Gudahl, Minister, officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery with graveside rites by the Independent Order of Odd Fellows.

He died Monday, May 8, 2000, at Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Albert was born October 5, 1909 at Dalton, Neb., the son of Henry W. and Eunora (Bancroft) Krewer. At an early age his parents moved to the Dwyer Community and then to Wheatland where he grew up; attending Wheatland schools and graduating from Wheatland High School with the class of 1930. He was a salesman for Krewer Pool Hall, selling and delivering confectionery tobacco products to smaller towns around Wheatland.

He married Marjorie Norris on August 20, 1934. He worked at odd jobs and then the Great Western Sugar Beet factory during campaigns until 1941 when he started working for G.O. Nixon Grocery. In 1945 he was inducted into the United States Army. After training, he served in Manila, Philippines for the 138th Military Police Battalion.

Returning home, he went back to work for G.O. Nixon Grocery. When the store sold, he worked for Alexanders, then Jack and Jill until retiring in 1976.

He was an active member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Independent Order of Odd Fellows and the First Christian Church. He enjoyed family, traveling, puzzles and snowbirding to Mesa, Ariz. for 12 years.

Survivors include his wife, Marjorie of Wheatland; a daughter, Janice Spaulding and her husband, Jerry of Casper; brotiner, Charles Krewer and his wife, Lillian of Cheyenne; four grandsons and their wives, Bud Foshier and wife, Sue of Elkridge, Md., Robert Spaulding and wife, Janel of Fort Collins, Brent Spaulding and wife, Penny and Jim Spaulding and wife, Tammy, all of Casper; one granddaughter, Vicki Brown and husband , Bret of Peru, Ind.; ten great-grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.

Preceding him in death were his parents; one daughter, Glenda Foshier; and two sisters, Myrtle Higgins and Ruth Krewer.
