

KUEHNER, DORRIS VIRGINIA HEINTZELMAN

December 21, 1917-May 8, 1966

Many friends were shocked by the death of Dorris Virginia Kuehner, a Wheatland resident since the age of 12. Mr. Kuehner was born in Denver, Colo., December 21, 1917 and was married to G. Frank Kuehner at Rocky Ford, Colo. on January 29, 1938. Two children, Ted and Roberta were born to this union.

Mrs. Kuehner attended the University of Wyoming and later taught at the Shaw Ranch and at Uva. She was a member of the Catholic church and a 25 year member of the Rebekah Lodge.

She was claimed by death in the Platte County Memorial Hospital on May 8, 1966 following an illness of four weeks.

Rosary services were held at the Schrader Chapel at 7:30 p.m. Tuesday evening. Services were conducted by Father Leonard Wren at the Church of St. Patrick May 11 at 10:00 a.m. with interment in the Wheatland cemetery. Pallbearers included Gay Robbins, Ned Bryant, Merritt Gano, Jack Melugin, Jack Eddleman and Laurel Smith.

Family members surviving are her husband Frank, and son Ted, both of Wheatland, daughter, Mrs. Roberta Tibbetts of Aurora, Colo., mother and step-father, Mr. and Mrs. J.T. Doyle of Loveland, Colo.; brother, Edward Heintzelman, Loveland, Colo., and half-brother, Ralph H. Stratton of Cheyenne.
