

KUEHNER, EDNA HANNAH BORRALL

November 5, 1880-December 20, 1978

Funeral services were held Saturday, Dec. 23, 1978, for Edna Hannah Kuehner, 98, at the First Christian Church with Daniel Barcus officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Kuehner passed away Wednesday, Dec. 20, 1978, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Wing.

Edna was born in Warren County, Iowa, Nov. 5, 1880. She came to the Wheatland area in 1895 in a covered wagon with her family. She worked with her parents and sisters building the irrigation ditches around the Wheatland area. She and G.H. Kuehner were married March 5, 1902 in Wheatland and homesteaded in the Sturgeon Gulch area. They moved back to Wheatland and operated the Community Grocery Store for a period of time.

She was a member of the Rebekah Lodge and a charter member of Wheatland Country Women's club. She was affiliated with the First Christian Church.

She is survived by two sons, Frank Kuehner and Roy Kuehner both of Wheatland; three daughters, Mary Dunham and Wilma Davis of Wheatland and Rae Trabert of Napa, Id.; eleven grandchildren; twelve great grandchildren and five great great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband Dec. 4, 1950; on brother Owen Borrall, Two infant brothers; four sisters, Carrie Hightower, Ina Combes, Alice Nanney, and an infant sister, Annie.

Serving as pallbearers were Lee Dunham, Ted Kuehner, Bob Trabert, Jim Dunham, Ron Davis, and David Dunham. Schrader-Prell Funeral Home was in charge of the arrangements. A memorial has been established to the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Wing.
