

Rhoda May Lambert

March 6, 1916 – July 3, 2005

Graveside services and interment for former Wheatland resident, Rhoda May Lambert, 89, were conducted at 11 a.m. on Friday, July 8, in the Wheatland Cemetery at Wheatland.

She died Sunday, July 3, at Pikes Peak Care Center in Colorado Springs, Colo.

Rhoda was born March 6, 1916, in Gering, Neb., the daughter of Archie and Maudie (Blanton) Snook. She moved with her family in 1926 from Nebraska to Greeley, Colo., by covered wagon, and then to Wheatland where they made their home. She married Peter Andrew Lambert in Gering, Nebraska, on Feb. 7, 1934. She and her husband moved to Novinger, Mo., where Peter worked for three years and their oldest son was born. After this they moved back to Wheatland and spent their remaining years. Rhoda

enjoyed entertaining the nursing home residents by singing and dancing the wheelchairs, crafts, and hunting.

Survivors include two sons, Marion T. Lambert and Albert L. Lambert both of Wheatland; two daughters, Elsie Keith of Colorado Springs and Alice Haynes of Wheatland; two brothers, Victor Snook of Lander, and Delbert Snook of Wheatland; a sister, Ella Jones of Moody, Texas; 15 grandchildren; 34 great-grandchildren; 21 great-great grandchildren; and many friends and other family members.

She was preceded in death by her parents; husband, on July 3, 1986; a grandson; one great granddaughter; and three great-great grandchildren.
