Services for Zedia Louisa Lambert, 84, who died
in Wheatland, Aug. 28, were held Tuesday,
September 2, at 2 p.m. in the First Christian
Church with Chet Shaw, Minister.

Zedia Lambert was born, January 18, 1902, in
Lincoln County, Kansas, the daughter of John and
Hattie (Richards) Williams. She was educated in
Max, Neb. At the age of 16 she came to Wheatland
where she met Joseph E. Lambert. They were
married April 1, 1921 in Benkleman, Neb. In 1924
they settled in Wheatland to farm and ranch, and
