Mrs. T.J. Lane, seventy-two years of age, who died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Joseph Rutherford, at the foot of Laramie peak Tuesday, was interred here Thursday afternoon. The funeral was held at the Rutherford residence Thursday morning at 9:00 after which the drive was made to this city.

Up to little more than a year ago, Mrs. Lane's health was excellent. At that time she made a trip back east to visit a son. Since her return, she has been failing. About three weeks ago, she fell while walking across the dining room floor and fractured her hip. The shock, together with other afflictions resulting from age, proved too much for her fragile condition.

Mrs. Lane leaves a son in the east, William Lane, and Mrs. Rutherford, her daughter. She was a woman of splendid qualities, and many friends will grieve to hear of her death.
