

LANGE, ELLA VIOLA WHIPPLE  
April 19, 1912-January 25, 1977

Funeral services were held Friday, January 28, 1977, for Ella Viola Lange at the United Methodist Church with Rev. Elliott Graves officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mrs. Lange passed away at the age 64 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Tuesday, January 25, 1977.

She was born in LaGrange April 19, 1912. A lifetime resident of this area, she attended and graduated from Chugwater High School. She was married to Ernest O. Lange in July 18, 1932. He preceded her in death in 1972. For many years she was employed as a nurse for Dr. Allison and also had worked as a bookkeeper.

Mrs. Lange was a member of the Wyoming Flying Farmers for over 25 years. She was the Queen of the Wyoming Flying Farmers in 1963 and was treasurer of this organization for many years. She was the head of the cooking staff for Lions Club and was a member of WSCS of the Methodist Church.

In death, she is survived by a son, H. Pete Lange, of Wheatland; a sister, June Billings, of Wheatland; and one granddaughter. Her father, A.O. Whipple and one brother, Howard Whipple, preceded her in death.
