

LARSON, MINNIE H.
July 25, 1869-December 23, 1945

Funeral services were held Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Schrader funeral home for Mrs. Minnie Larson, 76, mother of Mrs. Earl Harvey of Slater and of Elmer Larson, former Wheatland resident. The Rev. W.W. Maxwell officiated and pallbearers were Earl Romig, Oscar Throckmorton, Wes Blevins, Lee Blevins, Joe Weber and John Manger. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mrs. Larson was born in Falkoping, Sweden, July 25, 1869 and passed away in St. Anthony's hospital in Denver, Sunday, December 23, following a two months illness. She came to the United States 60 years ago and has been a resident of Cheyenne for 30 years.
