

LAUCK, PETER J.

March 4, 1883-December 20, 1944

Funeral services were held in the Evangelical Lutheran church Wednesday at 2 p.m. for Peter Lauck, 61, who died in the Wheatland General hospital following a three day stay. The Rev. John Erbes of Lingle officiated, and burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Peter J. Lauck was born in Russia March 4, 1883 and came to this country 40 years ago. Mr. Lauck was a farmer on the Wheatland flats for many years, and only recently retired and moved to town.

Besides his wife, he is survived by four sons, Herman of Climax, Colo., Ben of Frontier, Edward of Camp Rucker, Ala., and Alexander who is serving with the United States navy; four daughters, Mrs. Clara Williams of Loveland, Colo., Mrs. Glenn French of Climax, Colo., Mrs. Howe McCrae of Gainsville, Geo., and Mrs. Jim Holpin of Meade, Colo.; one brother, Louis of Wheatland; and several cousins.
