

## Alice J. Leedy

WHEATLAND — Services for Alice J. Leedy, 80, will be conducted at 2 p.m. Saturday at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland by Pastor Marlin Driskell of First Baptist Church. Burial will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Leedy died Wednesday April 28, 1993, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland. She was born June 13, 1912, in Volney, Iowa, the daughter of Amos Wesley and Della Elizabeth (Stafford) Jenkins. She grew up and was educated at Iowa Center.

On Aug. 15, 1933, she married D.F. "Bill" Leedy in Gering, Neb. The couple moved to her husband's homestead where they built their home. They later sold the property and moved to Horse Creek for six years.

Mr. and Mrs. Leedy then lived

in different places in Wyoming before moving to other western states in 1951.

In 1965, they moved to Arkansas then returned to Wheatland in June of 1978.

Survivors include her four sisters and two brothers: Irene McClure of Tenino, Wash., Bertha Hattan of Iowa Center, Wyo., Hazel Mundschenk of Torrington, Sue Cole of Paramount, Calif., Lewis Jenkins of Vale, Ore., and Robert Jenkins of Troy, Mont. Numerous nieces and nephews also survive.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband who died July 4, 1981, three brothers and a sister.
