

LEWIS, LODEMA D.

March 13, 1849-October 21-1924

Miss Lodema D. Lewis died about 9 o'clock Tuesday evening at the Wheatland hospital, after an acute illness of several hours duration, following a period of several months of failing health.

Miss Lewis was born March 13, 1849 in Besetta, Ohio, and moved, as a child, with her parents to Ia., and then to Illinois, where they resided twenty years at Warren. They then moved to northwest Missouri, where she resided until she came with her sister, Miss Julia Lewis, to Wyoming. Together they filed on homesteads eight miles southwest of Dwyer, where they continued to live, with the exception of a few months each winter, which they spent in Wheatland.

She spent a quiet Christian life, and was a general favorite among the circle of friends whose privilege it was to know her. She leaves to mourn her loss, two sisters, Mrs. J.T. Duffy and Mrs. Julia Thompson; and three nephews in this vicinity; county treasurer, Gale Lewis, postmaster Harold Duffy and Glen Duffy. The funeral was held at 10:30 this morning from the Methodist church. Rev W.W. Speer conducted the service. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
