

LINDSLEY, MARTIN J.
March 13, 1860-January 4, 1947

Born in Allegany County, New York, March 13, 1860, Martin J. Lindsley died at the Wheatland hospital after an extended illness on January 4.

Prior to making his home in Platte County in 1919, he lived in Columbus, Nebr.

Mr. Lindsley was a retired farmer and affiliated with the Methodist church.

Surviving are two sons, Frank W. and Earl of Columbus, Nebr.; three daughters, Gladys and Grace Lindsley and Mrs. Ray Neunberg, all of Columbus, Nebr.; one brother, Hale Lindsley of Wheatland.

Services were held Wednesday at 2 p.m. at the Schrader Chapel, Rev. W.W. Maxwell officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.
