

LOCKE, DOLLY ETHEL VANORTWICK

July 5, 1890-February 11, 1966

Services for Dolly Ethel Locke, a lifetime resident of Wheatland, were conducted by Mr. Dale Scheffler at the Schrader chapel on Feb. 14, 1966 at 2:30 p.m. with burial in the local cemetery.

Mrs. Locke, who was born on a ranch 20 miles west of Wheatland on July 5, 1890, succumbed to a long illness in the Platte County Memorial Hospital on Feb. 11. Her husband preceded her in death in 1959.
