

LOCKMAN, DAVID

September 15, 1890-November 6, 1955

Funeral services were held Wednesday, November 9, at the Wheatland Methodist church for David Lockman, 66, who passed away in a local hospital November 6 following a long illness.

Born September 15, 1890 in Russia, the deceased had farmed 20 years on the Wheatland flats, having come here from Colorado.

Mr. Lockman was a member of the Trinity Lutheran church of Wheatland. The Rev. Oscar Marquardt, pastor of the church officiated at the two o'clock service. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.
