

LOCKMAN, WALTER D.

September 12, 1920-October 26, 1973

Funeral services were held Monday, October 29, 1973, at 10:00 a.m. at the United Church of Christ for Walter D. Lockman, with Rev. Gordon Tritchler officiating.

Mr. Lockman, 53, passed away Friday, October 26, 1973, at Scottsbluff, Nebraska following an extended illness.
