

LOFING, HENRY  
November 3, 1899-October 31, 1976

Funeral services will be held for Henry Lofing Thursday, November 4, 1976 at 11:00 a.m. at the Trinity Lutheran Church of Wheatland with Pastor E. Rogness officiating. Burial will be at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Lofing died at the age of 76 Sunday, October 31, 1976 at his home after an extended illness.

Mr. Lofing was born in Norka, Russia November 3, 1899 and came to this country at the age of 12. While a young man in Windsor, Colorado, he met Mary Stroman. They were married May 23, 1920. The couple moved to Wheatland in 1929 to begin farming. They retired from the farm in 1969 and moved to town in 1970. Mr. Lofing was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church in Wheatland.

He is survived by his wife, Mary Lofing; two sons, Adam of Joes, Colorado, Robert of Kingsburg, California; one daughter, Mrs. Ken (Dorothy) Hanks of Wheatland; two brothers, Alex of Simi Valley, Calif.
