

LOGAN, HAZEL IRENE LEMLEY

February 23, 1889-January 30, 1967

Pioneer resident Hazel Irene Logan succumbed suddenly at her home on Jan. 30, 1967, at age 77. Mrs. Logan was born in Hiawatha, Kans., Feb. 23, 1889 and homesteaded in this area in 1916. She was a member of the Rebekah Lodge No. 16, Rock Lake Grange No. 13, and the Pleasant Hour Club.
