

LOOKER, MARY A. GABLE

October 5, 1844-1924

Mrs. Mary Gable Looker, well known Wyoming pioneer woman of Wheatland and Cheyenne, died Tuesday at the Wheatland hospital of heart trouble which was complicated by her advanced age.

Mrs. Looker had resided for the past 15 years at the home of her daughter, Mrs. G. Ryff, on the ranch south of Wheatland. She was aged 80 years, one month and 13 days at the time of her death, having been born Oct. 5, 1844 in Germany.

She came to the United States when a child, the family settling in Pennsylvania. She was married to David Looker on Feb. 19, 1864 at Meadville, Pa. They moved to Wyoming 30 years ago, settling first at Cheyenne, and then coming to Wheatland. Mr. Looker died 11 years ago.

She is survived by two daughters, Mesdames Elizabeth Brown of Cheyenne and Mrs. G. Ryff of Wheatland, by 10 grandchildren and four greatgrandchildren.

The funeral was held Wednesday afternoon from the Methodist church, Rev. W.W. Speer conducting the services, and interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
