

LOOMIS, HAROLD W. JR.
November 27, 1899-January 8, 1962

A sudden heart attack claimed the life of Harold Loomis, 62, prominent cattle rancher, as he and his son-in-law, Ray Lutterman, were en route to town Monday afternoon about 1:45. He was dead on arrival at the Platte Memorial hospital.

A lifelong resident of Wheatland, Loomis was born Nov. 27, 1899, the son of Harold W. (Mike) Loomis and Margaret McLaughlin. He was a member of the Congregational church, the Wyoming Flying Farmers, Wyoming Stock Growers Assn., National Stock Growers and Laramie Peak Stock Growers Assns.

Funeral services were held on Thursday, Jan. 11, at the Congregational church at 2 p.m. with the Rev. Donald Mills the officiating minister. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Pallbearers were Sonny Criss, Owen McGill, Frank Robinson, Mick Miller, Don Cundall and William Boyd.

Survivors include his wife, Mildred E., Wheatland; one son, Hugh Loomis, Omaha; a daughter, Mrs. Ray (Bonnie) Lutterman, Wheatland; one brother, Jack, and a sister, Mrs. Margaret Miller, both of Wheatland; and five grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his father and mother and one daughter.

The family has requested that memorials benefit the Platte County Memorial hospital.
