Longtime Wheatland resident, Effie M. Loughmiller, died Sunday, June 25, 1978 at the Eventide Manor in Cheyenne. She was 93. Funeral services will be held Friday, June 30, 1978 at 11:00 a.m. at the First Christian Church at Wheatland. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.
